Contacting the company

When work begins, please contact the Production Manager or the person responsible for the project.

Internal traffic

All visitors to AVL who are moving about in the work areas must follow the yellow gangways and be aware of moving vehicles.

Toilets

Toilets for external tradesmen and drivers are located in hall 20 and near the canteen in hall 10. Toilets for other visitors can be found in the administration building.

Smoking, alcohol and drugs

All the buildings in the company and all outdoor areas are non-smoking areas. However, smoking is permitted in the following areas:

In the smoking cabin in the administration, outside the cantina, at the storage office, at warehouse 23 and 15

Please REMEMBER to put all ash and stubs in the ashtrays.

Use of drugs and consumption of alcohol is not permitted. Any person under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be asked to leave the premises immediately.

Safety

Please ensure that you know the whereabouts of all fire-fighting equipment, first aid equipment, escape routes and emergency exits in the working area. Contingency plans and maps are displayed in various locations throughout the company's premises.

The company is subject to the rules of the ATEX directive, about explosive atmosphere. You can see in the contingency plans where the ATEX zones are. Inside these zones, smoking open fire are prohibited. The areas are marked with signs.

Fires and accidents

In case of fires or accidents, call **1-1-2**

Provide the following information:

- Your name
- Details of the incident
- Where the incident took place
(The company's address is Klostermarken 3, 9550 Mariager)
- The number of casualties

Assembly point

In the event of fire, anyone at Klostermarken 3 will assemble on the car park/gravel area next to the herb garden at Klostermarken 4, opposite to the main entrance to AVL.

Injuries and accidents

Any accidents, irrespective of whether or not there are any personal injuries, must be reported immediately to the Management System Administrator.

If any person suffering an injury requires transport to a doctor or hospital, the Production Manager will ensure that appropriate arrangements are made.

These records are used at our workplace to prevent injuries occurring on company premises

Organisation and tidiness

Please ensure that the workplace is kept tidy at all times. Keeping everything tidy and organised helps prevent accidents in the workplace.

Any uneven surfaces, holes, etc., that constitute safety hazards, should be clearly marked and cordoned off.

Any cables and hoses should be bundled and reeled in.

Work authorisation

Any person carrying out any hazardous work must have appropriate work authorisation, issued by the Production Manager.

The work must not commence until it is approved by the Production Manager.

The work authorisation does not absolve the contractor of his/her responsibility to ensure that the work is carried out in the proper manner and in accordance with Danish legislation on working conditions.

SAFETY RULES



Varmefodtøj påbudt

Safety footwear is mandatory throughout the factory, except in the administration building and on tours of the premises.



Hearing protection is mandatory in all areas with noise limits over 80 dB. These areas are signposted.



Hi-Viz clothing must be worn by anyone located in areas where lorries are operating.



Be aware of lorries and other moving vehicles when you are moving around the company's premises.



Open fire and smoking are prohibited.

THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

The contractor is responsible for complying with current legislation and regulations when carrying out any work at Aage Vestergaard Larsen A/S. Furthermore, the contractor is expected to be actively engaged in helping to prevent injuries and accidents.

The contractor is responsible for ensuring that their employees are provided with and use the required work clothes and personal protective equipment. The contractor is also responsible for ensuring that their staff have completed all mandatory courses relating to the work being carried out and that they are familiar with the content of this document.

WASTE

Aage Vestergaard Larsen A/S is an environmentally certified company. Accordingly, contractors and visitors are expected to comply with the company's environmental policy. Waste should be placed in designated containers.

ENVIRONMENTAL ACCIDENTS

In the event of accidents involving spillage of oil, chemicals or other environmentally harmful liquids, please ensure that such waste does not empty into the sewer. All environmental accidents, no matter how small, should be reported to your contact person.
